

Track A: Livelihoods stabilization in Ebola-affected communities (6-18 months)


Track B: Local Socio-Economic Recovery & strengthening of national/local institutional capacities (6-18 months)

What is Social Cohesion in the Iraqi context

- 'Force of circumstance' has brought together groups of people who would not have 'chosen' to be neighbors – host communities, Syrian refugees and Iraqi displaces people.
- It's not known how long they will be together
- They have different backgrounds
- Social cohesions is a way to help the groups to live harmoniously whilst they are together.
